Two camels walk with me.



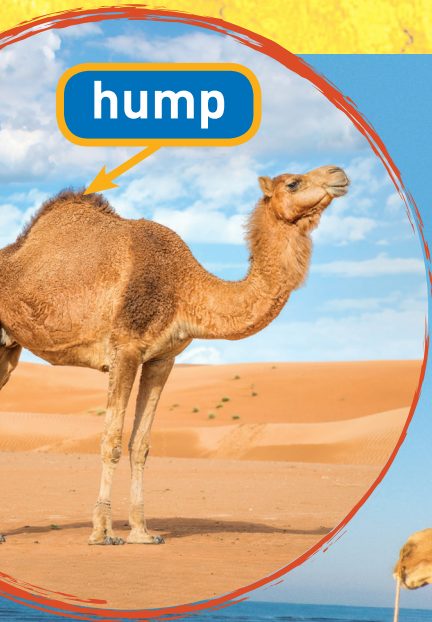


Fares
